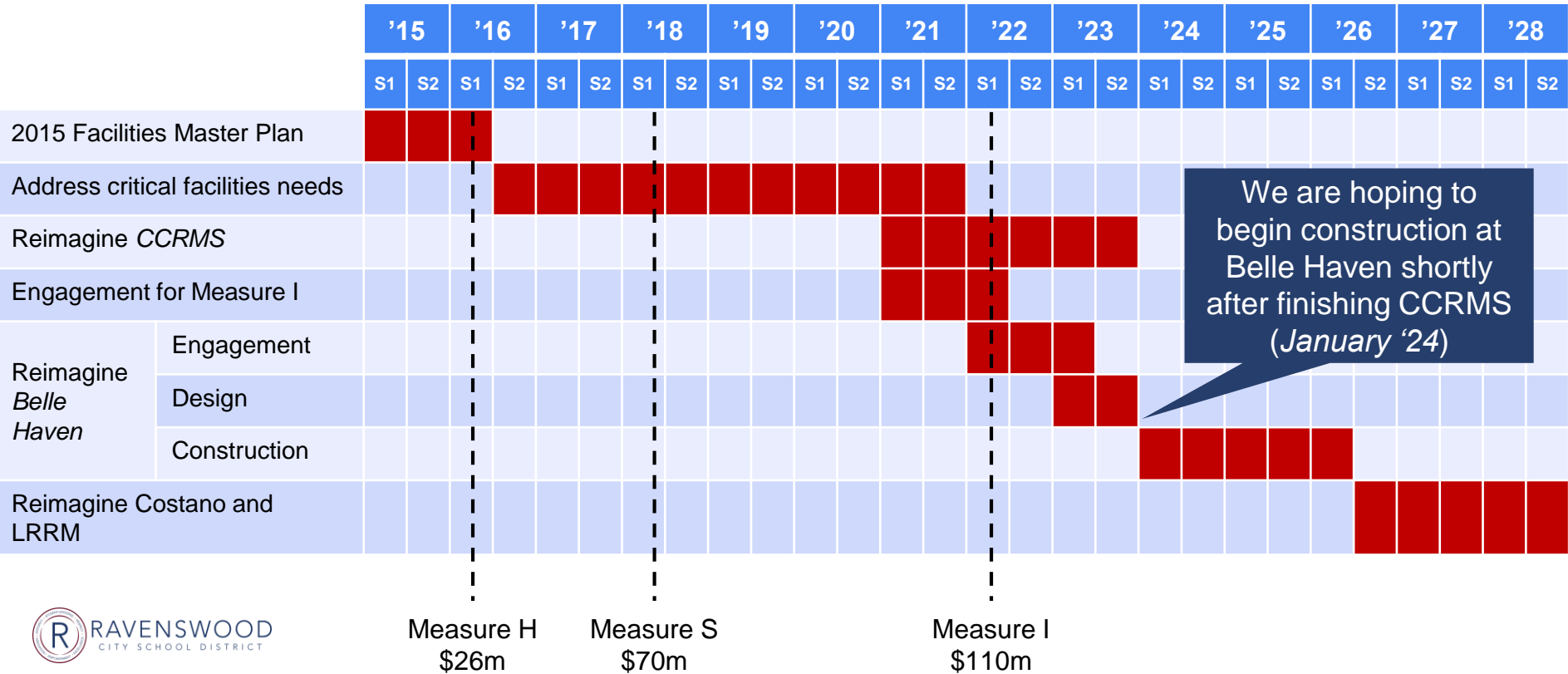

This timeline allows us to begin construction shortly after the completion of CCRMS

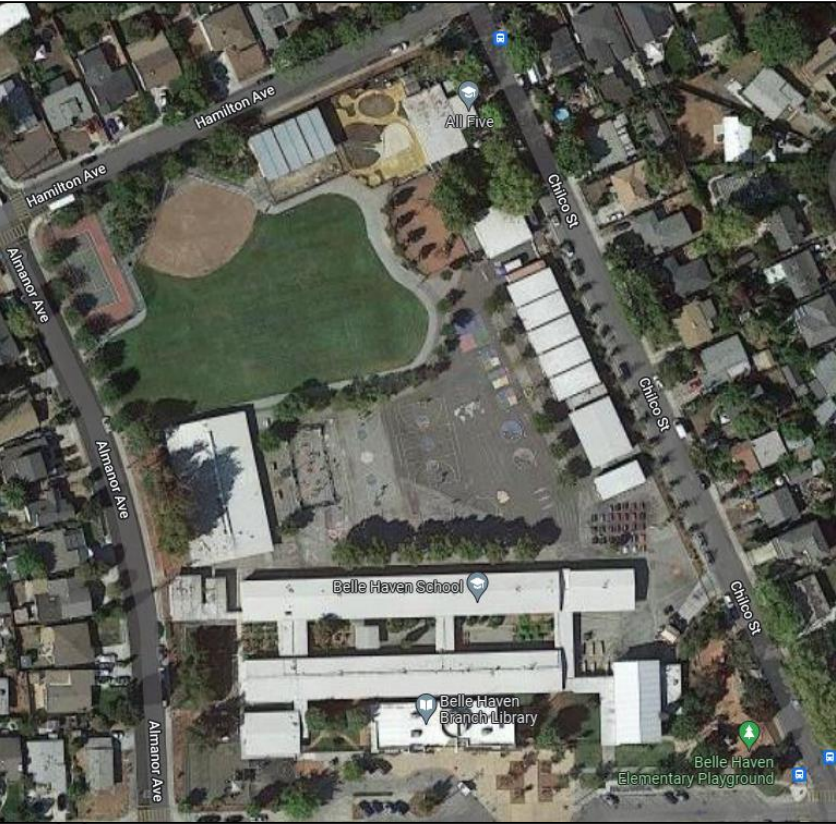
Community Engagement Plan

- Other community members

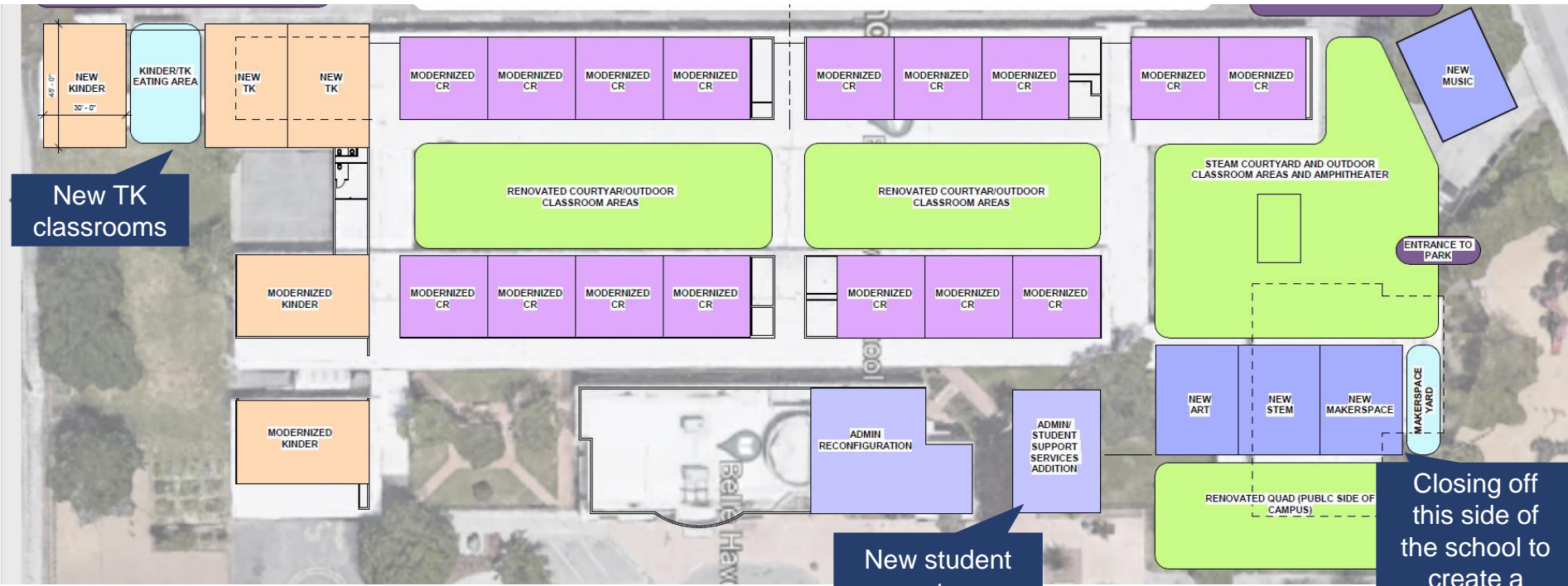
Belle Haven Elementary Reimagined

We are proposing renovating every structural classroom, building seven new classrooms, improving the outdoor spaces, moving the gym, and securing the campus



Belle Haven Elementary Reimagined

The core of the school is being modernized with new TK classrooms and new classrooms to the far right of the school



New TK classrooms

New student support space

Closing off this side of the school to create a secure core campus

Belle Haven Elementary Reimagined

Our initial proposal expands the gym, while moving it closer to the field entrance for easier community access; we are overhauling and redesigning the blacktop



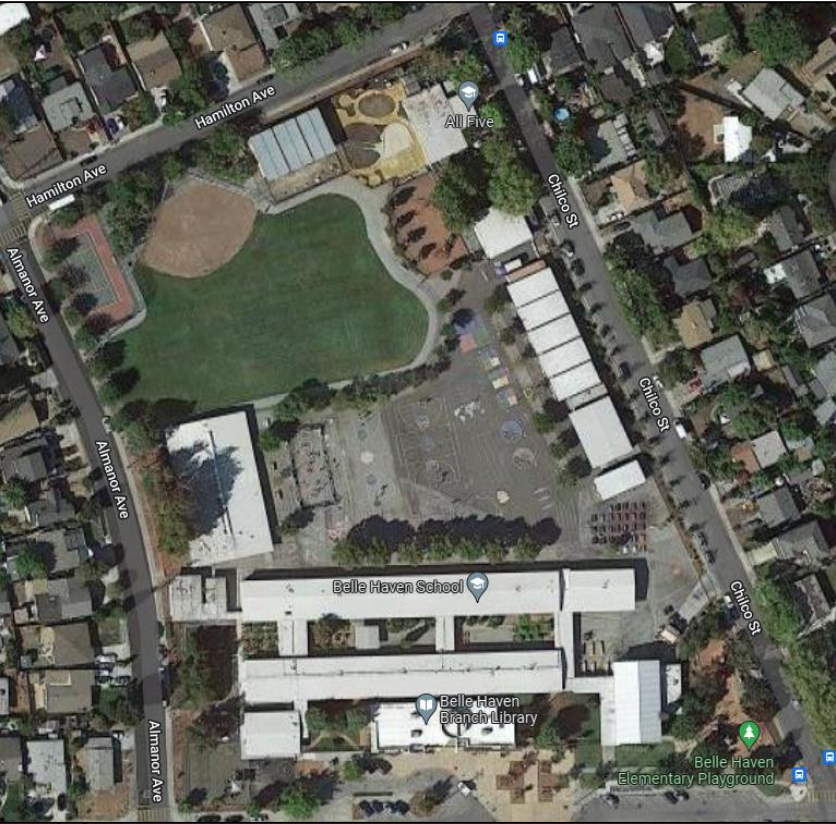
Belle Haven Elementary Reimagined

Should funding allow, we are proposing redoing the field at the back of the school

Putting it all together, we expect this project to cost approximately \$50m - as initially budgeted in Measure I
